## Possible solution to space issues topic of June 12 meeting

The St. Andrew's Vestry has taken seriously the input received from parishioners meeting in small groups at the Annual Parish Meeting in late February, and have called a special parish meeting for Sunday, June 12 at 6:30 p.m. to discuss with you a possible solution to one of the issues of major concern. Investigating options to accommodate more people at our 9:30 a.m. service, which is nearing capacity, the Vestry has found what it feels may be a workable solution for the near future. This solution would involve purchasing the house and buildings on the property adjacent to the church to the north for office and meeting space, and re-working existing space in the church building to increase seating in the sanctuary and ease congestion between services in the Narthex and hallways. The purpose of the June 12 meeting is to provide you with the financial and logistical details and discern the parish's feelings about proceeding with this opportunity. Please make every effort to attend this meeting of great importance in the life of our parish. Child care will be provided.
